# Section 2

## Format and Rules of the ANUDC

### Introduction to Debate format

The All Nigerian Universities Debate Championship (ANUDC) adopts the British Parliamentary (BP) debate format, recognized globally for its emphasis on quick thinking and strategic argumentation. This format divides debaters into teams of two, with each team either supporting or opposing the motion. There are four teams in a debate, making up two sides—Government and Opposition:

- **Opening Government (OG):** Proposes the motion.
- **Opening Opposition (OO):** Opposes the motion.
- **Closing Government (CG):** Also supports the motion, but must introduce new arguments.
- **Closing Opposition (CO):** Also opposes the motion, introducing new arguments and rebuttals to the Government's case.

Each speaker delivers a speech in the order of OG, OO, CG, CO. The first and last minute of each seven-minute speech is protected from interjections, known as “Points of Information” (POIs), from the opposing teams.

### Structure of the Competition

Each debate round features four teams—two representing the Government and two representing the Opposition. The teams receive the motion only fifteen minutes before the debate begins, requiring them to quickly formulate arguments and strategies without external assistance. This setup tests their ability to think on their feet and draw upon a broad base of knowledge.

### Rules and Scoring

The rules of ANUDC are designed to ensure fairness and intellectual rigor. Ranking and speaker points are awarded based on the logical consistency of arguments, the relevance of examples, and the persuasive delivery of speeches. Judges, who are experienced debaters and academics, are trained to be impartial and to evaluate arguments based on their merits rather than on the speakers' personal characteristics.

### Role of Judges

Judges play a critical role in maintaining the championship's high standards. They provide constructive feedback to participants, helping them improve their debating skills and understanding of debate strategies. This feedback is crucial for personal development and helps maintain the educational focus of the event.

### Progression and Awards

Teams accumulate points over the preliminary rounds based on their performance. The highest-scoring teams advance to the knockout stages, which culminate in the championship final. Awards are given for the best teams, best speakers, and a variety of other categories that recognize exceptional talent and effort throughout the tournament.
